INVITATION FOR BIDS

Medical Teaching Institutions (MTI) Mardan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa was established under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Medical Teaching Institutions Reforms Act, 2015 to improve performance, enhance effectiveness, efficiency and responsiveness for the provision of quality healthcare services to the people of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Hospital Director MTI-MMC Mardan, invites sealed bids from the Eligible Contractors registered with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in Cat-6 or above for repair & maintenance works at MMC Hospital in light rule 31A Framework contract. The bidding procedure will be conducted through "single stage one envelope procedure" of KPPRA Rules 2014.

Bid Solicitation Documents containing detailed description including BOQ, evaluation criteria and other terms and conditions may be obtained from the undersigned office, between 09:00-15:00 hrs. On any working day (Monday to Friday) by depositing a sum of FRS. 2000/- as "Non Refundable. The advertisement may also be downloaded from www.kppra.gov.pk and www.mmckp.gov.pk websites.


The bidders / contractors are required to submit bid security (in original) @ 2% of the estimated cost mentioned in the bid solicitation documents in the form of Call Deposit Receipt (CDR) / Demand Draft (DD) in the name of "Hospital Director MMC Mardan".

The bids complete in all respect should reach the undersigned by 11:00 hrs. On 19 April 2022 (Tuesday), which shall be opened at 11:30 hrs. On the same day (in conference room of the hospital) in the presence of procurement committee and the contractors/ representatives, who may choose to attend?

General Terms & Conditions:-

- i. The bidders should be registered with FBR and reflected on Active Tax Payer list (ATL).
- ii. All the bidders should also be registered with KP Revenue Authority (KPRA).
- iii. In light of SRO No (13)Nol: 1-21/2021-22, The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 15% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security to the extent of 2% of Engineer Estimate only.
- iv. The contractors quoting their bids more than 15% below on Engineer's Estimate shall submit along with their bids and Additional Security to the extent of their bid/rates more than 15% below on engineer estimate in the form of percentage.
- v. In case the bidder quotes more than 15% below the Engineer Estimate and the bid is not accompanied by the Additional Security then the bid shall be considered as non-responsive and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- vi. In case a contractor quotes more than 30% below on Engineer Estimate, the procuring entity shall, in addition to additional security, require the contractor to produce detailed rate analysis of his bid price in relation to any or all the items of bill of quantities, scope of work, allocation of risks and responsibilities and/or any other requirements of the bid solicitation document.
- vii. Incomplete, Conditional and Bids without Bid Security shall be considered as non-responsive.

Competent Authority reserves the right to reject any or all the bids as per provisions contained in Rule 47 of KPPRA Rules 2014.
